What is TIDES?

TIDES is an ambitious partnership between Live Argyll, Dunoon Burgh Hall and CHARTS, funded by Creative Scotland. Led by Producer, Iain Maclean of Production House Studios, Glasgow, TIDES aims to meet some of the challenges musicians face as a result of the pandemic and the lockdown halt to live music.

TIDES is a complete online music festival being designed around a range of genres from the Cowal Peninsula and will also highlight a range of other performers from Argyll and beyond.

The project aims to highlight a vibrant and wide range of new music which has emerged over recent months to premier online on March 27th, to reach national and international audiences.

When do I need to be available?

TIDES will be filmed between late February and mid-March. You will need to be available for filming at Dunoon Burgh Hall and a schedule will be set up to meet social distancing requirements.

Awards

Awards up to £500 are available for around 10 individuals and/or bands.

Who can apply?

To be offered an award of £500, musicians need to:

- Live in Dunoon or on the Cowal Peninsula
- Have new work ready to release – priority will be given to new music
- Be flexible to meet a tight schedule plan
- Have previous experience of live performing

As work which is not new may also be considered for the festival with good reason – please provide reasons in your application.
